PASSPORT

If you do not have a passport you will need to apply for one as soon as possible, <http://www.usps.com/passport/welcome.htm>. We have to have all passports by **JUNE 1, 2017** to finalize airline tickets. Passports must be valid for at least 6 months from our return date.

IMMUNIZATIONS

If you have any health questions you can contact the Greene County Health Dept. or go to www.cdc.gov, www.tripprep.com or www.who.int. There is nothing required for this trip. We always recommend that everyone have their Tetanus/TDAP, Hepatitis A & B shots for all trips.

LUGGAGE

Each team member will be allowed to bring one suitcase weighing 50 lbs, one small carryon bag and one personal item like a computer bag or purse. We will go over this in more detail at our meeting.

COST OF TRIP

- \$2,100 per person
- WorldProject Committee is donating \$300 per team member bringing the cost to \$1,800 per person
- This includes Air Fare, Lodging and Meals
- Payment Schedule
 - \$300 payment due as soon as possible. This guarantees a spot on the trip for the first 15 people that pay.
 - \$500 May 1
 - \$500 June 1
 - \$500 July 1
- This cost includes your airfare, lodging and 2 meals a day while in Germany
- Depending on your shopping needs, \$300 for souvenirs, snacks and additional tours should be plenty
- Deposits are refundable until May 1.
- Checks need to be made to High Street earmarked with your Name/Germany or you can pay online at HighStreet.org.
